LEICESTER ROAD

PARISH OF UPPINGHAM ORDER 2018

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Parking Restrictions) Leicester Road Parish of Uppingham Order 2018, as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates specified below all vehicles will be prohibited from parking in the bays, along the length of road known as Leicester Road for 507m.

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 5th February 2018 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 69 days. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs are erected on site.


The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 5th February 2018 until 13th April 2018.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises whilst the work is being carried out.
